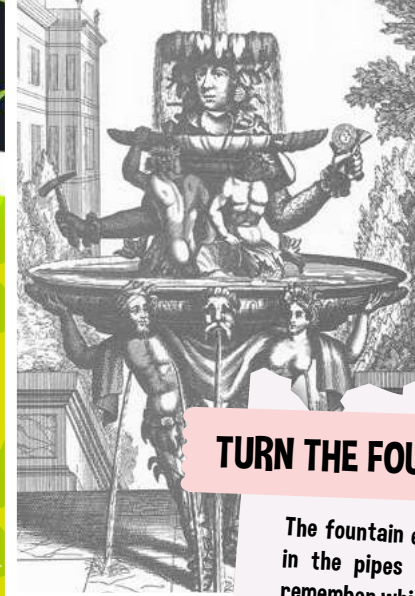
1 - THE WATER PARTERRE

We need to get Fluff back first, because she'll be helpful in getting time back to normal. To do that, let's head for the water parterre. Large underground reservoirs were dug out under this place. A lot of water was needed to supply all the water for the water jets in the gardens of Versailles. Louis XIV's fountain designers thought a lot about it... They dug ponds, built aqueducts and even imagined a gigantic machine designed to bring water from the Seine. But ultimately, it was rainwater from the surrounding area that provided the water for the water jets. It goes through several fountains one after the other before it gets to the Grand Canal at the bottom.



ANECDOTE

Today, there are "only" 600 water jets left in the gardens. But when Louis XIV was here, there were 1,400. There was never enough water to supply them all at the same time. The fountains were only started up when the king's was passing by. The fountain engineers whistled to warn that the sovereign was about to come by. Hurry, get the sluice gates open!



TURN THE FOUNTAINS ON

The fountain engineer has seen Fluff hiding in the pipes of a fountain, but he can't remember which one. Help him find the right way to activate the fountains, and reveal Fluff's location.



2 - THE LATONA FOUNTAIN

Ladybug looks at this fountain in awe, there must be a Kwami in it. This fountain tells you the story of Latona who protected her children Diane and Apollo from the peasants who wouldn't let them drink water from the spring. Latona asked Jupiter, her husband and king of the gods, to punish the peasants by turning them into animals. So you can see frogs, turtles and lizards, who are actually peasants that have been turned into them.



THE TURTLES IN THE FOUNTAIN

The sculptor has spotted Wayzz hiding near the Latona Fountain. He is willing to tell you his secret hiding place, but only if you help him by answering his question: How many turtles are there in the pond? (Circle the correct answer)

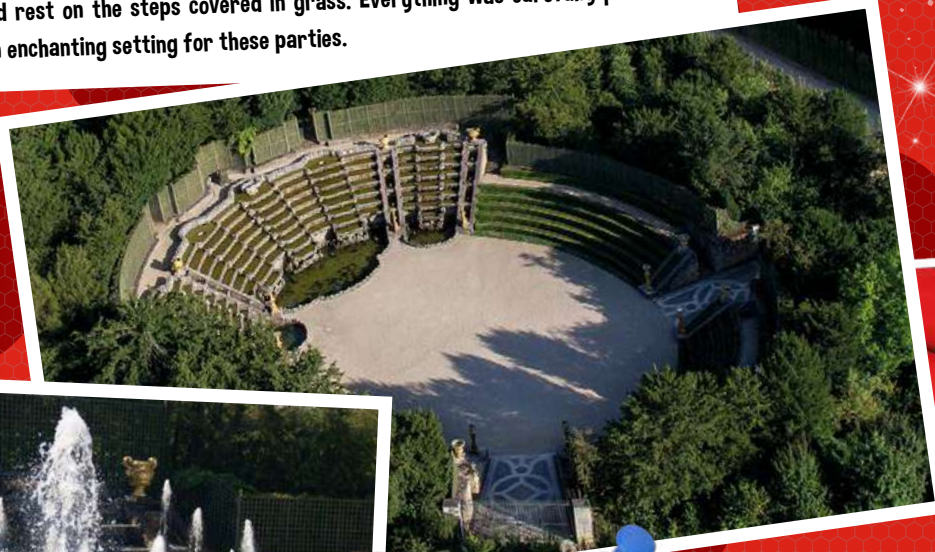

ANECDOTE

From 1687 to 1689, Jules Hardouin-Mansart made Latona turn around. First of all, the statue was facing the rising sun, the Palace. But now she faces the setting sun.

3 - THE BALLROOM GROVE

Welcome to the "disco" of the gardens of Versailles! Louis XIV organised spectacular celebrations here to amaze the nobility. It took more than 20 years to build the palace before the court could finally move to it. Luckily the gardens were ready a lot faster. This meant that lavish outdoor parties could be organised in them. At the heart of this grove, a dance floor made of real marble was installed for people to dance on, surrounded by a peaceful stream. When the courtiers were tired of twirling around, they could rest on the steps covered in grass. Everything was carefully planned to create an enchanting setting for these parties.



💡 ANECDOTE 💡

The musicians were set up at the top of the waterfalls. They got out their violins, oboes and drums, and played music by Jean-Baptiste Lully, Louis XIV's favourite musician. Lighting was provided by torches in golden torch holders around the dance floor. It had a lively ambience all night long!



ZIGGI'S DANCE

To hide from Timetagger, Ziggs has chosen to discreetly join the dancers at the ball! Find Ziggs and draw a circle around her so she joins our team!



Answer: behind the dancer at the back on the right



4 - THE MIRROR POOL

Now it's time to leave the dance floor and move on to the next puzzle, because time is running out. Welcome to the Mirror Pool. Louis XIV ordered this fountain to be made around 1702. It is built in front of the King's Garden, and Jean Hardy was asked to sculpt the two dragons which frame the fountain. The pools is set on three levels, and leads to five paths and four statues from Antiquity, including one of Apollo.



💡 ANECDOTE 💡

When you stand in a particular place, the water in the pool perfectly reflects the sky and surrounding trees, creating the illusion of a natural mirror.



FIND THE REAL TRIXX

Trixx has found a spot above the Mirror Pool to create an illusion, and trick Timetagger. Find the real Trixx and circle the correct answer to get him back to the team!

5 - THE COLONNADE GROVE

Designed by architect Jules Hardouin-Mansart, the unique character of this place is what makes it stand out. Here, there aren't as many plants as in the other groves, because it was designed by an architect, and not a gardener. You are surrounded by 32 marble columns in different colours, that form a circle around you. In the centre, there is an imposing statue showing Proserpine being kidnapped by Pluto, her future husband and god of Hell.



💡 ANECDOTE 💡

When Le Nôtre, the gardener for the other groves, saw this creation, he showed he was jealous by saying to the king: «You have made a gardener of a builder. He has served you a dish from his trade.»



MUSICAL PUZZLE

Mullo has hidden in the instrument used by the musician: the Marine Trumpet. If you can solve the musical code, Mullo will reveal herself.

6 - APOLLO'S FOUNTAIN

This fountain is dazzling! It's Apollo's fountain, the Sun god himself. During the day, he crosses the sky on his chariot, lighting the world. When night falls, he goes to rest in Thetis' grotto, at the bottom of the waters. Apollo reigns supreme in the garden of Louis XIV, the Sun King. But is that really just a coincidence? In fact, when Louis XIV alludes to Apollo's adventures through his statues, he is putting himself on show. He wants his garden to say loud and clear: «Look how handsome and powerful I am!»



ANECDOTE

It is the oldest fountain in the park. It was dug when Louis XIII was king and has all the royal symbols: Apollo, dolphin, a jet of water as a fleur-de-lys. Louis XIII liked to go hunting there and had a hunting lodge built that he could sleep in at Versailles. His son Louis XIV transformed the Château into this huge palace.



KAALKI

The fountain engineer has seen Kaalki hiding in the Apollo fountain. Answer his questions, and he'll show you where the Kwami is!

- 2 - I am a marine mammal with a famous smile and I escort Apollo. Who am I?
- 3 - The central water jet forms the emblem of the kings of France. What is it called?

7 - THE ENCELADUS GROVE

Cat Noir can't believe his eyes: who is this statue trapped in the stone supposed to represent? This giant wanted to conquer Mount Olympus, the mountain where the Roman gods lived. Like the plans of the super-villains Ladybug and Cat Noir are up against, his plan failed spectacularly. Jupiter, the god of the gods, struck him with lightning and buried him under a mountain of stones to punish him. This statue is pretty scary... But that's on purpose! Louis XIV wanted to warn everyone: don't attack me or you'll regret it.



💡 ANECDOTE 💡

Ladybug has noticed some very strange-looking trees around the grove. These are topiaries, plants cut to give them special shapes, which are often geometric or artistic. This means shaping the branches and leaves into shapes that have been drawn, to create plant sculptures.

8 - THE GROVE OF THE THREE FOUNTAINS

Le Nôtre designed this grove in 1677, and it is unique, as it is the only one mentioned on an old plan as being "of the King's design". It runs parallel to the Water walk, and is laid out on three distinct levels connected by cascades: in the lower pool, the jets form a fleur-de-lys, in the centre, a water vault, and in the upper pool, a water column formed by 140 jets.



ANECDOTE

This grove features three different-shaped pools: an octagonal pool, a square pool and a round pool. It is distinguished by the absence of statues and the presence of many shells.



IN ALL SHAPES

Sass is in the octagonal pool (8 sides), circle the pool that corresponds to this shape to find it.

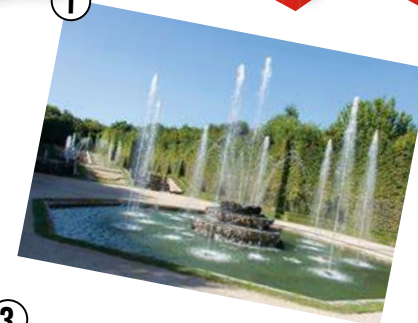

9 - THE DRAGON AND NEPTUNE FOUNTAINS

You only have one Kwami left to find! He can only be in one place: the Neptune fountain. This fountain is impressive because it has almost 100 water jets on its own! It's a real water show... By the way, the statues around it represent all the myths related to the sea. In the middle, you can see the god of the Sea, Neptune, holding his trident, next to Amphitrite, another sea goddess. Oceanus is on his right, a Titan who is the father of 3,000 river gods, while his 3,000 daughters, the Oceanids, watch over rivers and lakes. On the left, you can see Proteus, who was a shepherd of sea creatures.



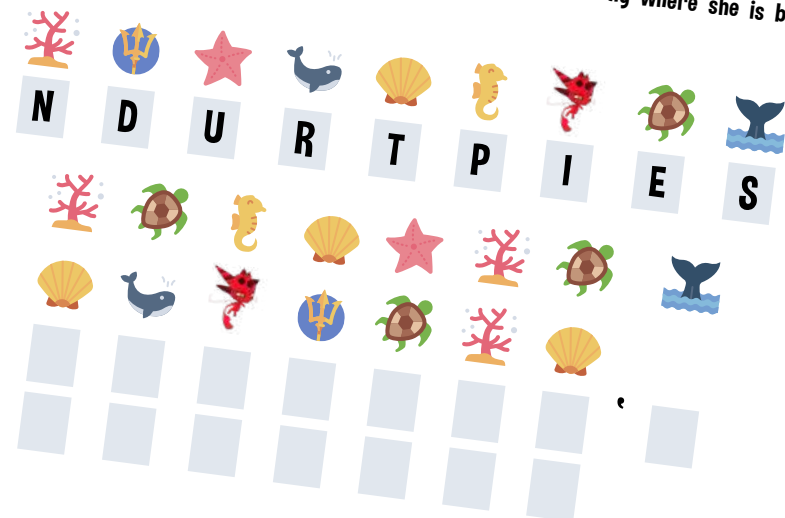
ANECDOTE

Like a powerful breath of fire, this dragon launches the most powerful jet in the park up in the air: a column of water that is 27 metres high. It symbolises Python, the snake beaten by the god Apollo, just the enemies of Louis XIV defeated by the Sun King...



LONGG UNDER WATER

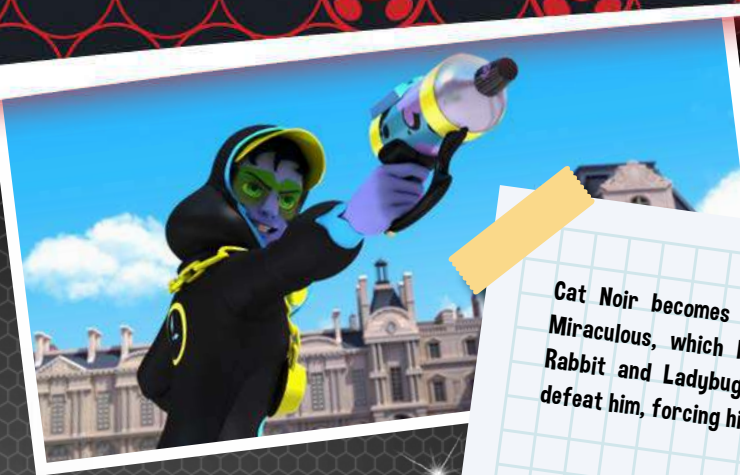
Longg has snuck into the Neptune Fountain. Find out exactly where she is by deciphering the code:

All has gone back to normal in the gardens of the Palace of Versailles. So now it's time to go back to the present time. Black Rabbit uses his power to bring everyone back to his time.
